

## **“Analysis of Law Enforcement Officers Killed or Assaulted”**

Completion of the attached eight-page questionnaire, “*Analysis of Law Enforcement Officers Killed or Assaulted*,” is requested on any officer assaulted or injured with a firearm, knife or other cutting instrument. Before completing the questionnaire, please read the following and check where applicable.

Please complete the attached questionnaire only when both criteria in A are checked.

- A.  Officer was on duty; if off duty, the officer was working in an official capacity at the time of the incident.
- Officer’s injury was sustained directly from a firearm, knife or other cutting instrument.

If B is checked, the questionnaire does not require completion. The monthly Law Enforcement Officers Killed and Assaulted (LEOKA) report accurately identified the weapon based on the Hierarchy Rule.

- B.  If more than one weapon type was used to commit a single assault on an officer, but injury was not sustained from a firearm, knife or other cutting instrument. (For example, a victim officer was threatened with firearm; however, officer was injured by personal weapons, i.e., hands, fist, feet, etc.)

If any criteria in C are checked, the questionnaire does not require completion. However, we request that an amended monthly LEOKA report be submitted.

- C.  Officer was off duty and was not working in an official capacity at time of incident.
- Officer was not injured.
- Officer was not assaulted.
- Officer was injured; however, the weapon was incorrectly reported as a firearm, knife or other cutting instrument.
- Officer was not assaulted with firearm, knife or other cutting instrument.
